HOUSING

Each room is furnished with 2 single beds, 2 desks, chairs, and an overhead light. Each person **WILL BE** responsible for providing a pillow, a blanket, linens, washcloths and towels. You may wish to bring bathrobes, alarm clocks, lamp, coat hangers, flashlight, soap and other toiletries. Other suggestions: Woolite, laundry detergent, waste basket, medicine for aches and pains (Tylenol/Motrin), ice pack, Pepto Bismal, band aids, and ace bandages. Rooms are air-conditioned. A key to your room will be issued at check-in. There is a \$50 charge for each key that is not returned at check-out. **WE CAN NOT ACCEPT ROOMMATE REQUESTS.**

FACILITIES AND SERVICES

Watson Commons will be your resident hall and will have an overnight contact whose phone number will be posted. There are free laundry facilities in Watson Commons for camper use. We suggest that campers not leave clothes unattended. Vending machines are also located in the resident hall.

MEALS

Resident students will receive all meals beginning with dinner at 6pm on Sunday, July 11 and concluding with lunch on Friday, July 23. Commuting students will have the opportunity to purchase breakfast, lunch, and dinner on campus each day.

TELEPHONES/MAIL

Watson Commons does not have pay phones. There is an active phone jack in each room if a camper wishes to bring his/her own phone. Campers will be able to make local calls from their rooms. For long distance calls a calling card with toll free access will be needed. If you wish to reach the camper (Monday through Friday, 8 am-5 pm) call Continuing Education at 912-478-5555 and we will get a message to the camper as quickly as possible. CHAPERONES

AIRPORT PICKUP

Georgia Southern University does provide airport pickup service from the Savannah/Hilton Head International Airport at a cost of \$50 per trip or \$100 roundtrip to the airport. Please complete a Georgia Southern University Transportation Form if this service is needed.

Upon receipt of your completed Application and Acceptance forms, Atlanta Ballet will send you a packet of information and forms to be filled out and returned. Please note that it is CRITICAL that health forms and waivers be completed and returned to Georgia Southern University prior to the beginning of camp in order for campers to be allowed to participate in the camp. If campers become ill, they will be taken to the Health Center on or the local hospital depending on the need.

CHECK-IN AND CHECK-OUT

Check-in will be at Watson Commons on Sunday, July 11 3:30pm-5:30pm. A welcome and orientation session will take place at Watson Commons after dinner. Campers will perform in a final performance on the final Friday of the program at 1:00pm. Maps and directions to follow.

DRESS CODE

Female students

Ballet and Modern :Atlanta Ballet burgundy logo uniform leotards Burgundy leotards, Pink tights, pink ballet slippers and pointe shoes.

Hair must be worn neatly away from the face and, if sufficiently long, secured in a bun. Skirts are permitted only in pointe class and only if allowed by the pointe class instructor.

Jazz: Any color leotard and tights, black jazz pants, and jazz shoes.
